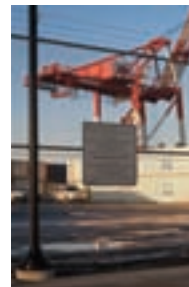


Get to know the Port of Halifax

Halifax is a bustling, modern city, home to Canada's East Coast Navy and the Canadian Coast Guard. It boasts the second largest natural harbour in the world – ice-free, with no tidal constraints. For centuries, it's been a welcoming port of call for the world's largest vessels. Today, it features two modern container terminals, and is one of very few ports on the East Coast of North America capable of handling fully laden post-Panamax vessels. Dockworkers are highly skilled and part of a dedicated, stable workforce.

CLEAR CUSTOMS IN SECONDS

In the Port of Halifax, cargo destined for the U.S. is pre-screened on dock by U.S. Customs officials. Through the harmonized security regulations with the U.S., when you provide shipping instructions electronically, the entire customs clearance process is efficiently expedited. Data can be provided electronically to all the parties involved: Canada Border Services Agency, U.S. Customs and Border Protection, ocean carriers, other rail carriers, custom brokers and any partners in the service delivery chain.



YOUR "COOL" PORT

Halifax specializes in handling your temperature-controlled cargo. Updated infrastructure at the Port of Halifax includes an impressive 1,000 reefer plugs and expanded terminal power – a major advantage for any shipper handling perishable goods.

Unlike some other eastern seaboard ports, Halifax has capacity to spare. That translates into savings, as there are no delays waiting for berthing. Halifax has capacity to more than triple its current container volumes. With minimal expansion and efficiency upgrades, Halifax could handle 2.5 million TEUs.
