**NOTICE OF FEE REVISION**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Halifax Port Authority proposes to increase cargo-related fees effective July 1, 2022, including:

- Tariff charges for commercial cargo to increase by 1%
- Non-electronic vessel cargo manifest tariff fee increasing to \$300
- U.S.A. cargo wharfage and Canadian import cargo wharfage increase of \$2.00 per container to support NTCF infrastructure projects
- Changes to Dangerous Goods Cargo Class 1, 5.1 and 7. The \$70 application fee to be replaced with a \$75 per container fee and \$7.50 per tonne bulk and breakbulk fee
